AN ORDINANCE OF THE PETERSBURG BOROUGH ADJUSTING THE FY 2017 BUDGET FOR KNOWN CHANGES

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Classification</u>: This ordinance is not of a permanent nature and shall not be codified in the Petersburg Municipal Code.

<u>Section 2.</u> Purpose: The purpose of this ordinance is to adjust the FY 2017 budget for known changes.

To add a Homeland security grant to the budget that had been unintentionally left out but previously approved by the Assembly.
