RESOLUTION #2016-19

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE OF SEPTAGE
DEWATERING EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the Petersburg Borough Wastewater department has the need to purchase septage dewatering equipment for the purposes of accepting and dewatering septage from local sewer maintenance activities, septic tank pumping and remote outhouse pumping; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of this equipment is included in the FY2017 budget as part of the Wastewater Composting Project in the amount of \$85,000; and

WHEREAS, the Wastewater staff has found that a Helisieve from Parkson Corporation is uniquely suited to dewater septage within the design of the composting slabs and septage receiving station recently designed by Harai and Associates; and

WHEREAS, the Parkson Corporation is a long standing leader in the industry of water and wastewater treatment who has supplied many reliable and durable pieces of equipment to the Petersburg Borough in the past; and

WHEREAS, the Wastewater staff has received a quote for a properly sized Helisieve from Parkson Corporation for \$79,000.00; and

WHEREAS, shipping of the subject equipment from Seattle, Washington to Petersburg, Alaska is estimated to be up to \$4,000.00; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in order to construct and commission the septage receiving station as soon as possible, but before winter 2016- 2017, and a dedicated bid process will delay the procurement of this equipment that normally has a lead time after order of 12 weeks; and

WHEREAS, it is in the Petersburg Borough's best interest, and the most efficient and cost effective action, to purchase the quoted equipment from Parkson Corporation of Vernon Hills, Illinois and pay for shipping to Petersburg, Alaska to accomplish completion of the septage receiving station as soon as possible.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Assembly for the Petersburg Borough approves of the purchase and shipping of a Helisieve spiral screening unit from Parkson Corporation of Vernon Hills, Illinois for a price not to exceed \$83,000.00.
