## PETERSBURG BOROUGH Resolution #2013-22

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ESTABLISHED PUBLIC NOTICE POSTING AREAS FOR BOROUGH BUSINESS – ADDING PAPKE'S LANDING DOCK APPROACH AREA

WHEREAS, the Petersburg Borough was officially incorporated on January 3, 2013 upon certification of the December 18, 2012 incorporation election, and

WHEREAS, the Petersburg Borough Charter in Section 3.02 C, designates specific posting requirements upon the adoption of an ordinance, and

**WHEREAS,** the Charter expressed posting areas for ordinances appear to be practical for use in the posting of general notices and

**WHEREAS,** Resolution #2013-01, adopted January 22, 2013 established the following official general posting areas for the Petersburg Borough:

The municipal office, post office, City of Kupreanof, Papkes Landing (The Trees RV Park); a visible Harbor facility area as determined by the harbormaster; at the Public Library on Haugen Drive (when construction is complete); and on the Borough's website. Public Service Announcements will continue to be read on the community radio; and

WHEREAS, residents from the rural areas of South Wrangell Narrows, Papke's, Green Rocks, Blind Slough, Keene Channel and Duncan Canal have requested that notice of borough business also be provided at the dock area of Papke's Landing; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received permission from both the Alaska Department of Natural Resources and Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to place and maintain a posting board near the dock approach at Papke's Landing.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Petersburg Borough Assembly directs that a public posting board be constructed, installed and maintained by the Borough at the dock approach at Papke's Landing. It is understood that the Borough will utilize this posting board as often as possible for public noticing purposes, excepting during inclement weather or when personnel are not available or able to make posts. It is also understood that if the posting board becomes an attractive nuisance and/or is vandalized on a frequent basis, the Borough Assembly, at its sole discretion, may order the board removed and any future posting in the Papke's Landing area will occur only in areas that are supervised or monitored, and fully accessible, on a regular basis.
