## Petersburg Borough, Petersburg, Alaska RESOLUTION #2016-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO GRANT AN AVIGATION EASEMENT FOR 3.39 TOTAL ACRES COMPOSED OF A PORTION OF LOT 14 AND THAT PORTION OF THE NE ¼ OF THE SW ¼ OF THE NE ¼ OF SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 58 SOUTH, RANGE 79 EAST, COPPER RIVER MERIDIAN, PETERSBURG RECORDING DISTRICT, FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT, STATE OF ALASKA, LOCATED AT 1601 HAUGEN DRIVE (PARCEL #01-014-500) TO THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION & PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT&PF)

**WHEREAS**, the Borough is the owner of the subject property as described above and has determined the property is not needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, while reviewing the property map of the James A. Johnson Airport, located in Petersburg, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) noted that a section of the required Runway Protection Zone (RPZ) is not within the boundaries of the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the FAA requested DOT&PF obtain an Avigation Easement that would allow the passage of aircraft at any height over the RPZ located over a portion of Government Lot 14 and the NE ¼ of the SW ¼ of the NE ¼ of S35, T58S, R79E of the Copper River Meridian; and

WHEREAS, DOT&PF has offered the Borough \$7,950 for the purchase of the Avigation Easement; and

**WHEREAS**, the James A. Johnson Airport is a vital transportation facility to the Petersburg Borough that provides a safe runway for private and commercial aircraft navigating in and out of Petersburg.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Borough Assembly of the Petersburg Borough approves granting of an avigation easement of 3.39 total acres composed of a portion of Government Lot 14 and that portion of the NE ¼ of the SW ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 35, Township 58 South, Range 79 East, Copper River Meridian, First Judicial District, State of Alaska, located at 1601 Haugen Drive (Parcel #01-014-500) to the Alaska DOT&PF for an amount not to exceed \$7,950.
