If creation of the proposed LID receives votes from properties that would collectively bear at least sixty-six percent (66%) of the projected cost of the assessment for the capital improvement, the Assembly may, by ordinance, approve formation of the LID and confirm and certify the assessment roll of the LID. If formation of the proposed LID does not receive the sufficient percentage of votes, then the process shall terminate.
