Ordinance #2016-08 amends Chapter 9.32, the Smoke Free Air Act of 2010, to add provisions for marijuana and specific language regarding electronic cigarettes and vapor products and amends the definition of litter in Chapter 9.12. Since its First Reading, Chapter 9.32 was amended to replace the word "cigarette" in the definition of "Smoking" with "nicotine delivery system". This Second Reading version of Chapter 9.32 also shows suggested changes requested by PIA's Tobacco Prevention Program Coordinator, all highlighted in yellow, on pages 4, 6, and 8 for the Assembly's review.

B. FY 2017 Department Head Salaries

Effective July 1, 2016, Borough union employees will receive a 2% increase to their hourly wage per negotiated contracts. The current FY 2017 Salary and Benefit budgets do not provide for any pay increase to Department Head salaries. During the budget process, the Borough budgeted for a possible 15% increase to health insurance premiums; however, the actual premium increase came in at just under 5%. This leaves approximately \$135,000 of budgeted and approved expenses unemcumbered for FY 2017, and Manager Giesbrecht has requested permission to give a 2% increase to Department Heads with a portion of this money, which would total approximately \$18,000 for FY 2017.
