PETERSBURG BOROUGH ORDINANCE #2014-11

AN ORDINANCE PLACING THE QUESTION OF EXEMPTION FROM AS 39.50, PUBLIC OFFICIAL FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE LAW, ON THE OCTOBER 7, 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION BALLOT

<u>Section 1. Classification:</u> This ordinance is of a permanent nature if approved by the electors, but shall not be codified in the Petersburg Borough Code.

<u>Section 2. Purpose:</u> The purpose of this ordinance is to submit to the voters of the Borough the question of whether our municipal officers and candidates should be exempt from the State of Alaska Public Officials Financial Disclosure law.

Section 3. Substantive Provisions

The Petersburg Borough Ordains as follows:

A) The question of whether or not to exempt municipal officers and candidates for elective office from the requirements of the State of Alaska Public Official Financial Disclosure Law (AS 39.50)shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the Petersburg Borough at the regular municipal election to be held on October 7, 2014; and B) The proposition to be submitted to the voters shall read substantially as follows: Shall the municipal officers and candidates for elective office of the Petersburg Borough be exempt from the requirements of AS 39.50, the State of Alaska Public Official Financial Disclosure Law? 0 YES 0 NO Severability: If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and application to any person and circumstance shall not be affected. Effective Date: This ordinance, if approved by the voters, shall become effective immediately upon certification of the October 7, 2014 municipal election results.
