**Re:** **In-Person Participation by the Public at Assembly Meetings Suspended During COVID-19 Crisis (Extended and Amended)**

Due to the ongoing public health emergency caused by the COVID-19 crisis, it is in the best interest of public safety and health that public gatherings be avoided. The conditions of this Mandate are designed to provide the least necessary restrictions.

In-person participation by the public during Assembly meetings, or any other public meeting of a Borough board and commission, was temporarily suspended. In order to ensure that the public's right to participate in such meetings is preserved, the Petersburg Borough has secured telephonic means for public participation, and the public is encouraged to participate by means of such call-in or by email, as set out below.
