Ordinance #2019-05: An Ordinance Authorizing Long-Term Indebtedness in an Amount not to Exceed \$8 Million for the Design and Construction of Water and Wastewater Infrastructure in the Borough, and Directing that this Matter be Submitted to the Voters for Consideration at the Next Regular Election to be Held October 1, 2019

Utility Director Hagerman requests approval of an ordinance authorizing a ballot measure for the October 1, 2019 election to ask the voters to approve long-term indebtedness which would be funded from the ADEC revolving loan fund for needed water and wastewater infrastructure projects. If the ordinance and ballot measure are approved the authority to incur debt will be authorized; however, the decision to move forward with a project is always contingent upon Assembly approval of a proposed loan as well as the Assembly's approval of a contract award. Ordinance #2019-05 was unanimously approved in its first and second readings.

Ordinance #2019-06: An Ordinance Adjusting the FY 2020 Budget for Known Changes
