**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SOUTHEAST ALASKA SOLID WASTE
AUTHORITY'S RECOMMENDATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN A REGIONAL SCRAP
METAL RECYCLING SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Petersburg Borough is a member of the Southeast Alaska Solid Waste Authority (SEASWA), a Municipal Authority formed under the guidance of Alaska Statutes 29.35.800 – 29.35.925; and

WHEREAS, the SEASWA has undertaken a public process to research and competitively solicit a regional scrap metal recycling service provider that is capable of providing service to SEASWA members; and

WHEREAS, the SEASWA has selected Waste Management, dba Waste Management National Services, Inc., as the regional service provider for long-term scrap metal recycling for Authority members and other regional communities; and

WHEREAS, the SEASWA and Waste Management have worked together to develop a draft Industrial Waste Services Agreement (Master Agreement) for the shipping and recycling of scrap metals and junk cars; and

WHEREAS, Waste Management will provide a financial proposal for Assembly approval, titled Exhibit A, as an integrated attachment to the Master Agreement that defines payments to the Borough based on current scrap metal market conditions, prior to committing the parties to a recycling service to the region; and

WHEREAS, the SEASWA Board of Directors has unanimously approved the Master Agreement with Waste Management and encourages member communities to complete the execution of the Master Agreement in advance of receipt of Exhibit A in order to reduce response time for establishing recycling services once favorable market conditions exist.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Petersburg Borough Assembly supports the recommendation of the SEASWA Board of Directors and authorizes the Borough Manager to execute the Master Agreement with Waste Management prior to receipt of Exhibit A to the Master Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Manager will request formal final Assembly approval of the Exhibit A prior to committing the Borough to any scrap metal recycling services provided by Waste Management as a result of the Master Agreement.
