To the Petersburg Borough Assembly,

I am writing to request a public hearing regarding the Kake access road as outlined in the Resolution presented to the Assembly at the council meeting on Monday, November 2, 2020. The purpose, scope, siting details and impacts of the project have changed so much that I believe the citizens of Petersburg need to be informed of the project as it is currently proceeding.

I am concerned that the current project does NOT appear to be supported by most affected citizens of both Petersburg and Kake.
