Thank you for discussing the University's upcoming Mitkof Island timber sale with me on January 27th. We look forward to our meeting in Petersburg on February 25th to discuss in greater detail and to address any concerns you or Mayor Jensen may have regarding the sale.

As information for our upcoming meeting, The University of Alaska (the "University") intends to offer to qualified individuals or entities the opportunity to harvest timber on the University's Wrangell Narrows East parcel. The Wrangell Narrows East parcel is located on Mitkof Island, approximately 14 miles southwest of Petersburg along the Wrangell Narrows. The total area for the Wrangell Narrows East parcel is approximately 368 acres. The tree species present consists of western hemlock and Sitka spruce.

Additionally, the University intends to offer the opportunity to harvest timber on the University's South Mitkof Island parcel. The South Mitkof Island parcel is approximately 29 miles southeast of Petersburg on Mitkof Highway. The total area for the South Mitkof Island parcel is approximately 658 acres of which 323 acres are old growth Sitka spruce, western hemlock and yellow cedar.
