Absentee voting will be open Monday, October 1 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon. Absentee voting is also offered by mail and electronic submission.

September 27, 2018 - Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail.

September 28, 2018 - Last day to file as a Write-In Candidate.
