RESOLUTION #2015-22**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT FROM
ALASKA PUMP & SUPPLY INC, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,485**

WHEREAS, the Petersburg Borough has budgeted and planned for the Pump Station 1 Force Main Upgrade project; and

WHEREAS, the pumps specified in the project design are a long lead time item; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to purchase these pumps early in order avoid related delays to the construction schedule; and

WHEREAS, the pumps specified in the project design are only available to Petersburg through a single dealer, Alaska Pump & Supply, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the quoted cost of the pumps is \$40,485, a purchase amount normally requiring a competitive bid process; and

WHEREAS, Borough Code allows exceptions to the bidding process for Single Suppliers, as described in Section 4.04.040, Paragraph C, of which Alaska Pump & Supply fits the description; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired for the Borough Assembly to waive the competitive bid process in order for the Borough to purchase the subject pumps from Alaska Pump & Supply.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Petersburg Borough Assembly hereby authorizes the Borough's purchase of pumps for the Pump Station 1 Force Main Upgrade project from Alaska Pump & Supply, Inc., without seeking competitive bids, in an amount not to exceed \$40,485. Steve Giesbrecht, Borough Manager, is authorized to execute any and all documents that may be required to facilitate the purchase.
