Issues to pursue

Proceed with the research and development of a complete list of Borough owned property for the purpose of presenting to the Assembly an actionable sale list.

Proceed with implementation of the land use designations that would set aside an area(s) that would allow tiny homes and smaller and more affordable dwelling units.

Proceed with the evaluation of the various fees in the Borough and research those that may be possible to fund Borough Services
