A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LICENSED USE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MORT FRYER BALL FIELDS TO THE PETERSBURG LITTLE LEAGUE

WHEREAS, due to Alaska's fiscal situation and the need to decrease Borough expenses, Petersburg Borough eliminated the Parks & Recreation Maintenance position whose duties included the maintenance of Mort Fryer Ball Fields; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide recreational services for the benefit of Petersburg's youth the Petersburg Little League (PLL) has agreed to undertake the management and maintenance of the ball fields, batting cages, concession facilities, and storage units in the truest sense of community partnership and mainly at their expense; and

WHEREAS, it is agreed between the parties that the Mort Fryer Ball Fields shall be used by the PLL for recreational purposes only; and

WHEREAS, subject to appropriation by the Borough Assembly, on or about April 1st of each year the Borough will provide PLL \$3,000 to cover utility expenses on the licensed property; and

WHEREAS, the PLL agrees to pay \$1.00 for the licensed use of the Mort Fryer Ball Fields for the term of the license agreement; and

WHEREAS, the term of the license agreement shall be in effect from March 7, 2016 to December 31, 2018.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Petersburg Borough Assembly approves the license agreement between the Borough and the Petersburg Little League for the use and maintenance of the Mort Fryer Ball Fields effective March 7, 2016.
