 - b. Survey/Engineering \$200,000. Permitting \$100,000. Total cost \$2.5M.
- 2. Expansion and improvements for the Banana Point and Blaquiere Point Boat facilities that improves transportation from and to Petersburg from Wrangell. \$3.2M
- 3. Dock, and affiliated facilities at Point Agassi.
- 4. Dock, ramp, and floats for Papke's Landing Facility. \$1.7M
- 5. Dock, and floats for the Kupreanof Facility. \$1.5M
- 6. Addition of ADA ramps to the South Harbor, \$2.2M
- 7. Essential Air Service continuation
- 8. Support for the Alaska Marine Highway System
