The Water department recently issued an Invitation to Bid for the Upper Dam Spillway Rehabilitation Project. This project will serve to repair the face of the dam's spillway after decades of erosion of the spillway concrete. The project was advertised in the Petersburg Pilot for two weeks and the bid opening was held on March 23rd at 1:00 pm in the Assembly Chambers.

The solicitation resulted in three bids being received. Bidders were Reid Brothers Logging & Construction of Petersburg, Ketchikan Ready Mix of Ketchikan and North Star Construction of Seattle. All bidders were found to be responsive and responsible to the bid requirements. The outcome of the bid process is presented below.

PND Engineers and the Water department have reviewed the bids, found no irregularities and hereby recommend award to the apparent low bidder, Reid Brothers Logging & Construction. An Intent to Award letter, informing the bidders of this recommendation, was sent to all bidders on March 23, 2018.

It is recommended by the Water department that the Borough Assembly award the Upper Dam Spillway Rehabilitation Project to Reid Brothers Logging & Construction, Inc. for a price not to exceed \$219,702.00.
