RESOLUTION #2017-20**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE OF ALL-HAZARD
WARNING SIRENS FROM FEDERAL SIGNAL CORPORATION**

WHEREAS, the Petersburg Borough was awarded and accepted a 2016 NOAA Tsunami Hazard Mitigation Program Grant for \$56,000 to purchase and install two (2) all-hazard warning sirens; and

WHEREAS, the sirens are intended to supplement the existing siren located at the Mitkof Middle School and increase our ability to reach a larger geographic area during a public warning notification event, such as tsunami evacuation, ammonia release, or fire notifications, and will be installed at the ballfield and in the Bay View Estates area; and

WHEREAS, Federal Signal Corporation is an experienced and qualified safety and security system service provider who has supplied and installed sirens for Federal, State, and Local governmental agencies throughout the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, with the purchase from Federal Signal Corporation the new siren activation will be compatible with the existing Federal Signal Corporation siren at the Middle School; and

WHEREAS, Federal Signal Corporation has provided the Borough with a quote for the purchase and installation of two (2) Eclipse 8 Omni-Directional Sirens for the total amount of \$55,689.33; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska granting agency (Alaska Department of Military and Veteran Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management) has authorized the sole source award of the project to Federal Signal Corporation.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Assembly of the Petersburg Borough approves of a sole source purchase of two (2) all-hazard warning sirens from Federal Signal Corporation for an amount not to exceed \$55,689.33.
