Dear Mayor Jensen and Manager Giesbrecht:

On April 22, 2020, GCI Communication Corp. filed an Application for Easement with the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Mining, Land, and Water to remove and relocate one of their fiber optic cables that crosses over four of the Southeast Alaska Power Agency's (SEAPA) cables in the Stikine Straits. Since SEAPA suffered a failure of one of its four cables, it requested GCI to remove their cable from its current position so SEAPA could replace its faulty cable and encouraged them to permanently reroute their cable to avoid future impediments. GCI is attempting to accommodate that request and the attached Public Notice from the Department of Natural Resources advises that the deadline for written public comment on GCI's request is June 1, 2020 at 5 pm.

SEAPA suffered a failure of one of these four cables and is requesting GCI to remove the fiber-optic cable from its current position over the power cables.
