AN ORDINANCE OF THE PETERSBURG BOROUGH ADJUSTING THE FY 2018 BUDGET FOR KNOWN CHANGES

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Classification</u>: This ordinance is not of a permanent nature and shall not be codified in the Petersburg Municipal Code.

Section 2. Purpose: The purpose of this ordinance is to adjust the FY 2018 budget for known changes.
