### Petersburg Borough Public Health Mandate #8: Face Coverings

#### Attachments: PB Public Health Mandate #8 - Face Coverings

This agenda item was requested by Assembly Member Meucci. If approved, Public Health Mandate #8 will require all persons, with some exceptions, to wear a mask of some form over their nose and mouth when (1) inside any building open to the public or any building not open to the public when present for work purposes and physical distancing of at least 6 feet from co-workers cannot be maintained, and (2) when outside of any building in situations where physical distancing of at least 6 feet from non-household members cannot be maintained, including without limitation, parking lots of buildings open to the public and Borough Harbor docks and floats. The Mandate will be in effect at 8:00 a.m. on November 17, 2020 and will remain in effect until rescinded by the Borough Assembly.
