## Approval of Five Year Lease Rate Adjustment - Petro 49, Inc.

Petro 49, Inc., formerly Harbor Enterprises, Inc. d.b.a. Petro Marine Services, leases land from the Borough that houses their office and facilities. The lease agreement provides the annual rental rate shall be subject to adjustment at each fifth year anniversary, based on changes in the fair market value of the leased property and improvements owned by the Borough. The five year rate renewal for the lease was established by an independent land appraiser. The appraiser has determined the new annual lease payments to the Borough to be \$70,197.82, up from \$66,290.99 in 2012.

Cotta Memo re Kiseno Sewer Main Replacement

At the June 19, 2017 meeting, the Borough Assembly voted to proceed with a loan application to ADEC for the Kiseno Street Sewer Main Replacement, in the amount of \$160,000. The preliminary loan application has now been submitted; however, the project needs to be included in the Borough's FY18 capital project budget.

On June 12, 2017, the Governor signed SB 100 that turned the mandatory property tax exemption for structures with sprinkler systems into an optional exemption. In Petersburg, all tax exemptions must be approved by the voters. This would simply retain the sprinkler exemption into future years.

First Bank is requesting a Security Assignment of Lease as collateral for the loan to K.C. Sales, Inc., d.b.a. S.E. Island Fuel. The Security Assignment provides that in the event of default by S.E. Island Fuel under the lease or default by S.E. Island Fuel under the loan documents in favor of First Bank, First Bank will have the option to acquire S.E.
