Re: South Harbor Launch Ramp Fish Cleaning Float Project Bid Award

On Tuesday April 22nd, 2014 the Petersburg South Harbor Launch Ramp Fish Cleaning Float Project bid opening was held at 2:00 pm in the Assembly Chambers. There were (3) responsive bids received and opened at that time. The lowest responsive bidder for the projects Base Bid was Tamico, Inc. with a total bid amount of \$166,000.

The Petersburg Launch Ramp Fish Cleaning Float Project will be funded through a CSMI – Southeast Alaska Chinook Salmon Mitigation Infrastructure Grant #13-CSMI-008 in the amount of \$225,800.00 awarded in September of 2013 to the Petersburg Borough on behalf of this capital improvement project. To date, \$21,000 of the funding has been spent in contract with PND Engineers, Inc. on design, engineering and bid preparation as well as close to \$2,000 on bid advertizing and processing. Funding left in the grant is approximately \$203,000.

I recommend moving forward and awarding the construction bid to Tamico, Inc. for their total bid amount of \$166,000. If you agree with this recommendation, please forward it to the Borough Assembly for consideration at their next regular meeting on May 5th, 2014.
