Ordinance #2016-09 uses DNR Grant funds on the Hungry Point Trail Extension project, provides for the use of National Forest Receipts Streets and Roads Fund monies to perform additional paving on specific local streets, and adds a Homeland Security grant unintentionally left off the FY 2017 budget to be used for the purchase of Public Safety Communications Equipment previously approved by the Assembly. There have been changes made since the second reading at the July 18, 2016 meeting. These changes reflect an increase of \$325,000 in the Harbor Department budget for a 50/50 match with the US Army Corps of Engineers on a feasibility study for dredging the South Harbor.

Adoption of this ordinance would render a Special Election on the subject unnecessary.
