Re: Permission to Place a Posting Board at Papke's Landing

The Borough has received written permission from the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, with concurrence from the local Department of Transportation, to place a posting board on the uplands adjacent to the dock at Papke's Landing. The approval was granted by an August 7, 2013 Letter of Non-Objection listing six terms/conditions for the use of the land. Permission to use the area for a posting board is for a 10 year period.

The posting board will be made by Petersburg School District along with other borough signs being constructed this fall. The board's construction completion date and ultimate installation are not known at this time. The board will be installed, maintained, and postings made, by borough personnel, either through the Parks & Recreation; Public Works or Community Development departments in conjunction with other work that may be performed in the area. It must be understood that this posting board will not always carry timely postings due to its location.

It is estimated that the annual cost to maintain the board and provide personnel for as frequent as possible posting will be about \$1,000. Cost to construct and erect the sign is estimated at \$750.00.

Please note, resolution #2013-22, allows for the Assembly to order the posting board be removed if it becomes an attractive nuisance or is vandalized.
