Re: Resurfacing South Harbor Ramps

As you know, the Harbor has been dealing with ongoing issues with the “slippery-ness of the South Harbor ramps. We continue to be concerned for pedestrians using the facility, especially during low tides during high traffic times of the year. Ideally the Harbor Dept would like to completely replace both 64 foot ramps with ADA compliant 85 foot aluminum ones, but that would require complete redesign of the upper dock and landing floats – this is on the Harbor’s capital list for future projects.

I held off proposing this maintenance project for the dust to settle from the Drive Down Facility Bid as well as waiting to see what this year’s Raw Fish Tax would be. With both coming in favorable, I would like to use up to \$16,000 from the Harbor Enterprise Fund to purchase these materials/freight as the maintenance line in the harbor budget cannot handle a hit of this size.

Our plan includes combining new fibergrate with the existing we purchased 3 years ago that will be detached, resurfaced and then re-align horizontally to fill in the full measure of the ramps. We also will add rungs similar to the MH ramp that will help pedestrian’s leverage as they climb the ramp at low tide.

The staff has gathered information and would like to order the materials soon in order to allow enough delivery time for project completion prior to the summer season. Attached estimates are for materials and freight only as the labor will be done in-house as part of our annual spring maintenance program.

If you agree with this recommendation, please forward it to the Borough Assembly for consideration at their next regular meeting on Jan 21st. Thank you.
