RESOLUTION #2016-03**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING FUNDING FOR, AND APPROVAL OF, A SOLE  
SOURCE CONTRACT FOR PAVING SERVICES TO SECON, A SUBSIDIARY OF  
COLASKA, INC.**

**WHEREAS,** The Petersburg Borough is in need of asphalt paving services to address various areas of degraded asphalt and chip seal; and

**WHEREAS,** it is prudent to repave areas of degraded road surfacing in order to better serve the driving public and minimize ongoing maintenance of these areas and the high costs thereof; and

**WHEREAS,** SECON, an experienced and qualified regional paving contractor, has mobilized to Petersburg to complete work associated with the Haugen Drive and South Nordic Resurfacing project and provides a contracting opportunity to pave degraded areas of pavement at reasonable costs to the Borough; and

**WHEREAS,** there are no other hot mix asphalt contractors scheduled to mobilize to Petersburg in the near future to provide a competitive bidding atmosphere for the required services; and

**WHEREAS,** SECON has provided the Borough with quotes for paving of various streets and patches in Petersburg, adding up to a total expenditure of \$532,085.00; and

**WHEREAS,** the Petersburg Borough's Special Revenue fund #250, Roads National Forest Receipts, contains \$364,599.00 in paving funds which may be approved as a supplemental expense in FY16 for paving projects; and

**WHEREAS,** funding in the amount of \$167,486.00 contained in the Rasmus Enge Bridge Reconstruction fund may be transferred to the Roads fund and approved as a supplemental expense in FY16 for use on paving projects with Assembly approval; and

**WHEREAS,** in accordance with Petersburg Municipal Code, the Borough Assembly must formally approve of all expenditures above \$30,000 as well as any sole source construction contracts contemplated by the Borough; and

**WHEREAS,** The cost of the paving contract is added into Ordinance #2016-01, an ordinance adjusting the FY 2016 budget for known changes, which has its first reading at the January 19<sup>th</sup> Assembly meeting and is scheduled for its third and final reading at the February 16<sup>th</sup> Assembly meeting.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Assembly of the Petersburg Borough approves of a sole source paving services contract with SECON for an amount not to exceed \$532,085.00.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Assembly approves of the funding transfers and expenses to fund the paving plan as subject to final passage of Ordinance #2016-01.
