

PETERSBURG BOROUGH

ORDINANCE #2019-11

AN ORDINANCE UPDATING CHAPTER 3.70 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, ENTITLED “PETERSBURG SCHOOL BOARD”, TO REFLECT BOROUGH INCORPORATION

Whereas, on January 3, 2013 the Election Division for the State of Alaska certified the election results of the December 18, 2012 incorporation election for the Petersburg Borough, and

Whereas, the certified election confirmed the incorporation of the Petersburg Borough and dissolved the City of Petersburg, and

Whereas, Petersburg Borough Charter, Section 19.06 requires all ordinances, resolutions, regulations, orders and rules in effect for the former City of Petersburg to continue in full force and effect within the Petersburg Borough, Service Area 1, until expressly reaffirmed, revised or repealed by the assembly.

Therefore, the Petersburg Borough Ordains, Chapter 3.70, as set out below, is hereby adopted as a borough ordinance.

Section 1. Classification: This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall be codified in the Petersburg Municipal Code.

Section 2. Purpose: The purpose of this ordinance is to update the language of the chapter to reflect borough incorporation.

Section 3. Substantive Provisions: Chapter 3.70 of the former Petersburg City Code with amendments as noted herein, is hereby adopted as a Borough ordinance and shall read as follows:

Chapter 3.70 – PETERSBURG SCHOOL BOARD

3.70.060	Meetings.

3.70.010 - Established.

The Petersburg school board is established as provided by state law and borough charter. The qualifications for election to the school board shall be as provided by state law.

3.70.020 - Composition.

The school board shall be comprised of five members. Vacancies shall be filled as provided by state law.

3.70.030 - Powers and duties.

The powers and duties of the school board shall be as provided by state law, borough charter and ordinance.

3.70.040 - Restrictions on dual office holding.

A member of the school board may not ~~serve on~~ hold any other elective ~~or elected advisory~~ office established by this code.

3.70.050 - Annual school budget.

The school board shall submit a proposed annual school district budget to the ~~council~~ borough assembly no earlier than May 1st of each year. The ~~council assembly~~ may by resolution require the school board to submit a proposed budget on or by a different date.

3.70.060 - Meetings.

~~A.~~ The board shall designate a public meeting area that is accessible to persons with disabilities, and all meetings will be open to the public and conducted in accordance with Alaska's Open Meetings Law. Meetings shall be given public notice as required in Chapter 3.10 of this code, and the meeting agendas shall afford an opportunity for the public to address the board.

Section 4. Severability: If any provision of this ordinance or any application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section 5. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage.
