

The Wastewater department recently issued an Invitation to Bid for the Scow Bay Pump Station 1 Upgrades project. This project will serve to replace the pump station with a new station that has more storage capacity and pumping capacity and is also more energy efficient. The project was advertised for 30 days and the bid opening was held on October 1, at 2:00 pm in the Assembly Chambers.

The solicitation resulted in two bids being received. Bidders were Reid Brothers Logging & Construction of Petersburg and Rock N Road Construction of Petersburg. All bidders were found to be responsive and responsible to the bid requirements. The outcome of the bid process is presented below.

PND Engineers and the Wastewater department have reviewed the bids, found no irregularities and hereby recommend award to the apparent low bidder, Rock N Road Construction. An Intent to Award letter, informing the bidders of this recommendation, was sent to all bidders on October 11, 2019.

It is recommended by the Wastewater department that the Borough Assembly award the Scow Bay Pump Station 1 Upgrades project to Rock N Road Construction for a price not to exceed \$445,600.00.
