Mandates, all of them.

It's refreshing to remember that this is not a bipartisan issue, or a bipartisan island. I feel better knowing that each of you want the same thing I do, for Peterburg to thrive. The best path towards that goal is the path that finds balance, a balance found through thoughtful risk-benefit analysis. Unfortunately, Facebook anecdotes, profit motivated media, and even the CDC are throwing our understanding of this illness out of balance.

Several days ago, Senator Rand Paul, a medical doctor, spoke out against the current lock downs, showing that blanket corona virus testing aboard a US military ship proves the virus to be 25-50% less fatal than originally feared. Senator Scott Jenson, also an MD, has blown the whistle on CDC inflation of Covid death numbers. Prediction models have pulled back on their guesses from the original (and scary) 2 million to somewhere around 60,000. Whatever you may believe about covid- think about this- many studies show that for only a 1% rise in the unemployment rate, our nation sees around 58,000 additional deaths that year. Take a close look at that statistic. Fact check it, please. What I'm telling you is that as our sense of purpose goes down, a thing called "all cause mortality" goes up. Right now our nation's unemployment rate is around 30% and people are struggling to meet primary needs with no income. Stress is high. Super high. Stress kills. Nobody knows what will happen from this much unemployment and social awkwardness, but 58,000 is still more deaths than covid has caused, even WITH the inflated CDC numbers.
