13 Marine Lease Amendment #2

Taylor and Scott Pullar, d/b/a 13 Marine, are requesting additional land for their Scow Bay lease in order to comply with State fire regulations - 20 feet on the north side of the leased property and 10 feet on the west side of the leased property, which would add an additional 1,900 sq. ft. to the lease and increase the annual lease rate by \$817.00 (current annual rate is \$1,290.00 + \$817.00 = \$2,107.00).
