Landscaping - Jesse O'Connor retires on April 30. He designed the library's gardens and has done a phenomenal job of taking care of them. We will miss him! This summer Matt Gerrits will take care of the grounds (mowing, weeding, watering) and Andrea Weathers will create and maintain our planters and hanging baskets.

FY21 Budget - CARES Act funding covered some of our expenses this year, as a result there are extra funds left in the budget. This will allow for the replacement of some IT equipment (domain controller, switches, computers) and the CCTV system to be purchased with FY21 funds.

Grants - Applications have been submitted for the IMLS Basic Grant (\$10,000) and Public Library Assistance Grant (\$7000). Both grants are used to purchase books and DVDs.
