

2018 Election Report
August 6, 2018

The annual Municipal Election will be held Tuesday, October 2, 2018.

1. This year's ballot will provide for the election of: 20 elected positions as follows:

- A. Two Assembly Members: Two - 3 year terms
- B. Three School Board Members: Two - 3 year terms, One – 2 year term
- C. Four Hospital Board Members: Two - 3 year terms; One - 2 year term; One – 1 year term
- D. Three Planning Commissioners: Two - 3 year terms; One - 2 year term
- E. Two Library Board Members: Two - 3 year terms
- F. Three Harbor Board Members: Two - 3 year terms; One – 2 year term
- G. Three Public Safety Board Members: One - 3 year term; One – 2 year term; One - 1 year term

2. Public Officials Financial Disclosure (POFDs) reporting will NOT be required due to the public's vote to opt out in 2015.

3. To date, there is 1 possible proposition to be placed on this year's ballot:

- 1) Whether to repeal the Senior Citizen Sales Tax Exemption and provide for an annual sales tax rebate to qualified senior citizens.

4. The first day to file for candidacy was Tuesday, July 24. Nominating petitions and declaration of candidacy forms can be obtained from the front desk of the finance office during normal business hours or online at the Borough's website. The last day to file for candidacy is 5:00 p.m., August 21.

5. The last day to qualify and register to vote at the election is September 2. Individuals can obtain voter registration forms at the Borough offices.

6. I am still working on securing this year's election officials. To date I have confirmed Mary Leonard, Mara Lutomski and Erica Worhatch. I am working on finding more help – if you know of anyone interested in serving, please send them my way!
