# Appendix C – Amendment 2 Description of Services

### Scope of Work

Contractor shall oversee COVID 19 greeting, customer service, screening, and testing services at the Petersburg Airport. Services must be provided to every inbound flight originating out of state.

#### **Amendment 2**

This amendment, Amendment 2, extends the contract term. The changes implemented as of this amendment are:

- The current Emergency Declaration is set to expire 11/15/2020. If this declaration does not get extended, the services of this contract may be terminated. Notice will be provided to the contractor as soon as possible, should the services need to be discontinued.
- · All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

# Assessment/adjustment

The contractor and project manager agree to meet as needed to assess functionality of all services, and adapt to
meet the current need. This may include scaling services up or down, implementing new processes, and
considering new workflows. The State will maintain the final authority for these adjustments, and approval must
be obtained prior to implementation.

# Transition of Services - End of Contract Term

• The State of Alaska's Procurement Code requires the purchase of services to be competitively solicited at the termination of a contract. This may result in a change of contractors from one contract term to another. Should that occur at the termination of this contract, the incumbent vendor is required to assist by facilitating a smooth transfer of the contracted functions to a new vendor or back to the purchasing agency.

# Appendix D – Amendment 2 Payment for Services

Payment for services provided shall not exceed \$423,725.00 for the period of performance of this contract.

#### Start up Costs

Training services for up to 15 employees.

Estimated 10 hours at \$50/hour
 Total Start-Up Costs: \$500.00

## **Estimated Daily Rate for Services**

Services shall be billed at actual costs for services used.

For the purposes of this contract, the following formula is used as an estimate:

- Greeters/Screeners 4 greeters/screeners X 2 hours X \$50 = \$400/day
- Testers 3 testers X 3 hours X \$50 = \$450/day
- Test Analysis Fee 10 tests per day X \$100/test = \$1000/day
- Test Shipping once daily X \$100 = \$100/day
- Printing expense (flat rate) = \$25/day
- PPE Expense (flat rate) \$50/day

Total Estimated Daily Rate - \$2,025.00 per day

The rates above shall be used to scale these services up or down as may be deemed necessary. Any variation to the formula above must be approved in advance by the Project Director, prior to implementation.

### Invoicing

The Contractor shall submit invoices to the address specified below no later than 30 days after the end the period for which services were performed. Failure to include the required information on the invoice may cause an unavoidable delay to the payment process. The State will pay all invoices within thirty (30) days of invoice approval by the Project Director.

The invoice must:

- Reference the contract number: C0620-523
- Include an invoice number
- Reference the Alaska Division of Public Health Emergency Operations Center (DPH EOC)
- itemize the contractual services provided during the period invoiced as described in Appendix C
