**Federal Priorities
FY 2022**

Transportation

1. Development and hard surface paving for the Airport (Petersburg) Bypass road.
 - a. Widen road to achieve two 12' lanes, provide base course and pave with 3" asphalt. Paving to extend from Haugen Drive/Quarry Road intersection to Hungerford Hill and on to Mitkof Highway. Rough construction cost \$2.2 million.
 - b. Survey/Engineering \$200,000. Permitting \$100,000. Total cost \$2.5M.
2. Expansion and improvements for the Banana Point and Blaquiére Point Boat facilities that improves transportation from and to Petersburg from Wrangell. \$3.2M
3. Dock, and affiliated facilities at Point Agassi.
4. Dock, ramp, and floats for Papke's Landing Facility. \$1.7M
5. Dock, and floats for the Kupreanof Facility. \$1.5M
6. Addition of ADA ramps to the South Harbor, \$2.2M
7. Essential Air Service continuation
8. Support for the Alaska Marine Highway System

Health Care

1. Renovation/Replace Petersburg Medical Center. Total Cost \$84M.
Final planning and project design to make the project shovel ready \$16.2M.
2. Overall health care costs in Alaska
3. Opioid addiction, treatment and law enforcement related to the issue

Environmental

1. Transboundary Rivers monitoring

2. Cruise ship impacts on Alaskan waters
3. Reduce/stop Mexico DPS Humpback Whale Critical Habitat Designation in Southeast Alaska – NOAA
4. Scow Bay Boat Haul out and wash down facility. Estimate of \$8.0M
